

CHARLOTTE MASON

- 1842 Born in England
- Educated primarily at home, father a Liverpool merchant
- Orphaned at 16
- 1860-61 Attended a training college for teachers
- Taught at an infant (elementary) school until 1873, Worthing, Sussex
- Lectured on Elementary School Teaching method at Bishop Otter Teacher Training College, Chichester, which was a forward-thinking school that included women
- 1878 Left BOC and went to Yorkshire. Began to write
- 1880 Published a series of books on the geography of England
- 1886 Home Education Volume 1 complete
- Parents' National Education Union (PNEU) established, later in 1890 published Parents' Review
- 1891 moved to Ambleside
- 1892 House of Education was established which was a college for teachers with an attached practicing school for local children
- 1923 died in Ambleside
